

Fellow Toastmasters in District 65,

Greetings.

In continuation of my e-mail dated May 31, 2014, titled "9-173-13-30 - How can you help?" I am updating the status of the "almost distinguished clubs."

Per TI website (as of 6/10/14) the following is the status of clubs that are "almost distinguished" and can become distinguished clubs (or better) with some additional efforts.

These clubs have already accomplished 4+ DCP (Distinguished Club Plan) goals and either needs to complete and achieve their remaining educational goals or meet the membership requirement of 5+ net increase (over July 1, 2013 base) and/or at least have 20 paid members.

The members and especially the leadership of these 32 clubs can accomplish these remaining goals with concentrated efforts during the next 18 days.

**EIGHT** of these clubs (highlighted below) need only 1 or 2 members to become distinguished club.

**SIX** of these clubs (highlighted below) need only 1 additional educational goal to become distinguished club. These clubs have met the "membership" goal.

I am requesting the ‘District Governor’ to forward this e-mail (if she chooses to do so) to the leadership of the above 32 clubs to take action. Thank you.

Thank you for your time and I hope with your efforts and leadership, we will together meet the distinguished club goals for these “almost distinguished” clubs.
